- After registering as a doctor with the Medical Council of New Zealand, complete 2 Years as a House Officer in a hospital.

ASSESSMENT

- 3 Years of General Practice specialist training and examinations with the Royal NZ College of General Practitioners.

REGISTRATION

- Become a Fellow of the RNZCGP
- Register as a vocationally registered General Practitioner through the Medical Council of New Zealand.
