- ACC is a joint purchaser of 9 Emergency Ambulance Service contracts with Health NZ
 - Exemption in the Accident Compensation Act for it
 - Via jointly funded Ambulance Team formerly NASO
- National Telehealth Service Healthline, Poisons line etc
- Public Health Acute Services
- PRIME Service contract No exemption in Act to jointly fund

PRIME Service – ACC angle

ACC works with Health NZ as closely as the legislation allows

- Joint schedule for PRIME in the Emergency Road Ambulance and Communications Services contract with Hato Hone St John (HHSJ)
 - $\,\circ\,$ sets out the eligibility for PRIME providers
- Jointly pay for PRIME training and kits (via HHSJ)
- Separate ACC contract with individual PRIME providers ie clinics
